1. **STPM / A-Level** or its equivalent: Pass STPM or its equivalent with minimum Grade C (GP 2.00) and full pass in 3 subjects; OR
2. **UEC:** Pass UEC with minimum Grade B in 5 subjects including Mathematics; OR
3. **Matriculation/ Foundation** or its equivalent: Pass Matriculation / Foundation with minimum CGPA of 2.50; OR
4. Pass Diploma (level 4, MQF) in Quantity Surveying at any HL1 recognized by Malaysia government with minimum CGPA 2.50; OR
5. Other equivalent qualifications recognized by Malaysian Government. AND Students international must pass:
 - a) IELTS Band 5, OR
 - b) TOEFL PBT(410-413), OR TOEFL IBT(34), OR
 - c) CAE (160)/CEFR B2, OR
 - d) CPE (180)/CEFR C1, OR
 - e) PTE (36), OR
 - f) MUET Minimum band 3.
